From the Pastor

- Here are a few more answers to questions about the capital campaign:

1. Donations are either restricted (second collections or capital campaign or building fund) or unrestricted (general offertory). All donations to the capital campaign are restricted, meaning they can be used only for the new building. If any substantial change is made on what was presented to the parish, then the parish cannot keep the money, but must return it. Monies donated to the building fund can be used for whatever is needed for the building. For example, any repair on the rectory, parish hall or church is paid for by that fund. All other monies are used for the operating budget. Any excess which is not used in the yearly budget is simply put in savings. Regular offertory income can be used for the building, since it is not restricted. But so far we have not used it for such.

2. No, OLMC has no debt. When I arrived there was debt, but it was paid off a few years ago. In fact, because of your generosity, we have gone from being in debt and having no savings to paying off our debt, making many capital improvements, and now having about \$450,000.00 in savings, in a period of less than four years.

3. Yes, there is a difference in lump sums and payments. The campaign is set for five years, making it
