It concludes that too much screen time can double the risk of attention problems in children and young adults. "The faster paced the show is, the more the problem happens. Real life doesn't happen fast enough to keep the youth's attention." Really? There are problems with youth spending long amounts of time in front of a screen? TV is different than reality? Who would have guessed?

### More News from the Music Department

"The great composers weren't called that during their lifetime, they earned the title. In many cases it was a title that they received long after their death. Consider that the great polyphonic composer Palestrina who wrote 104 masses (kyriales)... 104, that's astounding!!!! Professional choral musicians tend to perform less than 10% of his work but recognize that his genius is unmistakable. About 9 years ago I had the privilege of training and performing with Simon Carrington, the founder of the world renowned Kings Singers, he said that the Catholic Church's abandonment of most of Palestrina's work was a crime against high musical art. Remember that this is coming from a person raised as an Anglican and basically agnostic at this time. Pagans recognize the beauty of polyphony but Catholics today toss it aside for the unusual and novel. We must return to the root of our Catholic music and the foundational tradition of music; this includes music that is 100 years old or 1000 years old, it is all Catholic. Many will find music done in the
