As the project for the beautification of the sanctuary of the church begins on September 10, there are a few changes we need to make to accommodate this.

First, a lovely altar was made by Mr. J. P. Harbaugh and his sons, with assistance from Mr. Trent Davis. It has a tabernacle, and should do very well both for daily Mass and for Eucharistic adoration, which will continue during the construction.

The library in the parish hall will be used for Mass; the Blessed Sacrament will be reserved there during the week, and transferred into the church for Sunday.

The church will be turned over to the general contractor on Monday mornings, and then will be returned to us on Saturday evenings.

Confessions will be heard at the regular times, in the office on the northeast side of the back portion of the parish hall.

To make more room in the back portion of the hall, the food bank and AV equipment will be moved into the main hall in the corners of the hall, and we will discontinue the “free table.” Please do not bring anymore items for the free table.

If you need a place to drop off unused items, consider the ARC deposit station which is located on the south side of Littleton Blvd.

For First Saturday Masses, space may be tight, but with some overflow in the kitchen and connecting hall we should be able to manage.

For major feast days, such as All Saints, we will use the church.
