## From the Pastor:

- The Holy Hour this Thursday will be for an end to economic lockdowns in our country, which are harming so many.

- I was astounded by your generosity over Christmas in the collection. The regular collection combined with Faith Direct brought in \$80,000.00. Amazing.

- For Mass stipends, we need a slightly different system than we've been using. Please contact a secretary, instead of the individual priest, and she will let you know if we can say the Masses and how many we can receive. Checks should be made out to the parish, not to the individual priest, because we must declare the stipends for our taxes. The secretaries know how many Masses we can take per week.

- Let's review a good way to receive Holy Communion. First, as it is a food unlike any other, it should be consumed unlike other food. That is, once the Host has been placed on your tongue, instead of chewing or masticating, just let the Host dissolve or just use your tongue to consume it. But walking back to your pew while chewing gives the appearance of chewing anything else, such as gum, and this appearance should be avoided.

Next, remember that anything that can be moved on the body can be a problem in the reception! If you shift around

a bit on your knees, this presents a moving target for the priest, as does moving a baby around or the tongue doing a dance, or clamping down or biting or snapping at the Host. Keep the head level and not tilted back or forward. Place the tongue slightly over the bottom row of teeth, with the mouth open slightly. Close your eyes right after you have looked at the Host during the blessing, before the priest puts the Host on your tongue. Then immediately close the mouth (parents will need to remind the kids not to get up or turn their heads quickly with the Host on their tongues).

- The chandeliers for the parish hall are delayed until 2.1.21 ("due to Covid" was the reason given), and the sconces for the walls should arrive a week later. That will pretty much finish construction in the upper hall. Moving in and getting the rooms right will be ongoing. The hall will be blessed after the 6:30 AM Mass on the 24th. I know you will all miss the portapotty's in front of the hall – adding as they do to the curb appeal – but while the work continues in the basement, it is best for the construction workers.

- Several parents are making an effort to keep the little ones from running in the parish hall, and this is much appreciated.
