On the Liturgical "Reform"

The reformers discovered, after 1,500 years, that the Canon was a burdensome hodgepodge and stylistic mess. They would provide a series of better prayers in the new missal that could be used freely in place of the Church's most sacred and ancient liturgical formulation. Bugnini, the principal architect of the modern liturgy, wanted more "variety" ... These churchmen exhibited not a shred of humility before this incomparable work of art and component of the Western tradition, literary and spiritual. On the FBI Trump Raid

On Synodal Listening Sessions

Citing Pope Francis’ Traditionis Custodes, [Cardinal Wilton] Gregory decreed... that the traditional Latin Mass must end entirely at St. Francis de Sales on September 21... Indeed, many of these families had personally pleaded with Cardinal Gregory not to cancel their Mass at the synodal listening session in May. Alice von Hildebrand on the TLM

The devil hates the ancient Mass. He hates it because it is the most perfect reformulation of all the teachings of the Church... The problem which ushered in the present crisis was not the traditional Mass. The problem was that priests who offered it had already lost the sense of the supernatural and the transcendent. They rushed through the prayers, they mumbled and didn’t enunciate them. That is a sign that they had brought to the Mass their growing secularism. The ancient Mass does not abide irreverence, and that was why so many priests were just as happy to see it go.

On the Botafumeiro

The Santiago de Compostela Botafumeiro is one of the largest censers in the world, weighing 80 kg and measuring 1.60 m in height... Shovels are used to fill the Botafumeiro... with about 40 kg of charcoal and incense. The thurible is tied to the rope with elaborate knots... The thurible’s swings almost reach the ceiling of the transept. The incensory can reach speeds of 68 km/h as it dispenses thick clouds of incense. At the top of the swing, the Botafumeiro reaches heights of 21 meters. It swings in a 65 meter arc between... the ends of the transept. The maximum angle achieved is about 82°... One tradition has it that the use of a swinging censer in the Santiago de Compostela Cathedral began in the 11th century. Arriving pilgrims were tired and unwashed... There have been a number of accidents which occurred during the swinging of the Botafumeiro over the years... One of the most renowned accidents took place during a visit of Princess Catherine of Aragon. She was on a journey to marry the heir to the English throne in 1499 and stopped by the cathedral in Santiago de Compostela. While it was being swung, the Botafumeiro flew out of the cathedral through the... window. No one was reported to have been injured on this occasion.
